a. Derry Osborne

Under Chapter 30, Article 23, Subsection 12 of the Code of State Regulations, students enrolled in medical imaging programs are exempt from medical imaging licensure requirements while completing their clinical training.

Derry Osborne requests that the Board consider permitting medical imaging students to be exempt from existing licensure requirements when employed by local hospitals outside of their school's clinical training program. In the alternative, he requests that the Board consider

establishing a licensing pathway that would allow medical imaging students who have not yet met the qualifications for full licensure to engage in employment in medical imaging roles.

Passed Senate Chamber - February 26, 2026

The Board is updating its statute and regulations to enhance clarity, public safety, and alignment with current standards. Key changes include:

1. **Radiation Therapists:** Licensure requirements added to reflect modern education pathways; therapists can now earn a degree directly in radiation therapy without first completing radiography school.
2. **Moral Character & Criminal Convictions:** Outdated “moral turpitude” and “good moral character” requirements removed; only healthcare-related criminal convictions affect licensure.
3. **Podiatric Medical Assistants:** Licensure and scope of practice requirements eliminated for assistants performing limited, low-risk imaging, aligning with dental imaging exemptions.
4. **Examinations:** State-specific exams removed; national certification exams (ARRT, NMTCB, ARMRT) now suffice.
5. **Scopes of Practice:** Updated for radiologic technologists, MRI technologists, radiation therapists, and nuclear medicine technologists to match ASRT national practice standards.
6. **Temporary Licenses:** Eliminated due to accessibility of electronic national exams, ensuring only fully certified technologists practice independently.
7. **Radiologist Assistants:** Oversight transferred from the Board of Medicine to the Medical Imaging Board; requirements and scope updated to align with ARRT certifications and ASRT recommendations.

15. Virtual Supervision for Contrast-Enhanced Imaging Procedures

In April 2020, during the COVID-19 public health emergency, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) temporarily allowed virtual supervision for contrast-enhanced imaging procedures. CMS extended the virtual direct supervision policy several times and ultimately made it permanent on January 1, 2026.

On 7/3/2025, [§18-6-5](#) was added to change "physician" with "licensed practitioner" as referenced in §30-23-10 (Scope of Practice for a Radiologic Technologist).

Do we need to update [§18-6-5](#)?

It is within the scope of practice of a medical imaging and radiation therapy technologist to perform the parenteral administration of contrast media after consultation with, and under the general supervision of, a prescribing licensed practitioner who is immediately and physically available to ensure proper diagnosis and treatment of adverse events.

The Board incorporates by reference the ASRT's *Practice Standards for Medical Imaging & Radiation Therapy*, which state that the administration of contrast media falls within the scope of practice for Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy professionals, provided they are educationally prepared and clinically competent.
