14. **Elimination of Temporary Six Month License for New Graduates**

According to published records from the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT), 57 out of 510 West Virginia graduates did not pass the national registry examination on their first attempt within the previous five years.

The Board previously voted to eliminate the temporary license provision in the proposed code change, determining that temporary licenses are no longer necessary due to the ready availability of electronic national examinations and the Board's expedited licensing procedures. These advancements represent a significant departure from the conditions underlying the original 1977 regulation, when certification examinations were administered only twice annually.

The code revision, including the deletion of the temporary license provision, will be reintroduced next year.

Given that the current language in §30-23-13 uses the term "may," the Board retains discretion in issuing temporary licenses. In light of the 57 graduates who did not pass the certification examination over the past five years, the continued issuance of temporary licenses raises important public safety considerations. Individuals who have not yet demonstrated minimum competency through successful examination may be permitted to practice, potentially increasing the risk of diagnostic errors, improper radiation exposure, or compromised patient care.

Accordingly, the Board should consider whether the immediate discontinuation of temporary licenses is warranted as an interim measure to protect public safety until the proposed code revision can be formally adopted.

15. **Creation of a General Radiography Student Permit**

A General Radiography Student Permit would authorize radiography students to perform general radiographic procedures prior to graduation from an accredited radiography program and before successfully obtaining radiography certification.
